I would like to thank the support staff, sponsors and all our partners that have equally contributed to 5 years of transforming lives in Uganda’s poorest and marginalized communities.

As we rejoice about our accomplishments in 2010, the good fight to see the transformation of as many lives of orphan children and their communities as possible must continue steadfastly. Mountains of hope continues to work with orphan children and their communities to give them a better future. Through the organizations programmes and activities, Mountains of hope shall continue to prioritise the children’s welfare spiritually, physically and economically.

Since its establishment in 2005, Mountains of hope Uganda continues to diligently work with the little orphaned children and the poorest communities to promote transformation in line with Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) and Uganda National strategy.
